For those larger/group of employers paying the apprenticeship Levy, from April 2018 you will be able to transfer up to 10% of the annual funds in your apprenticeship service account over to an ATA for the use of such service. Further guidance on how transferring funds between organisations will work, in practice, will be given in autumn 2017.

#### THE BENEFITS OF AN APPRENTICE

Organisations of all sizes benefit from apprentices. Studies by the British Chambers of Commerce and the Centre for Economic and Business Research found apprentice employers reporting the following benefits:

Greater productivity - 81% of apprentice employers say they make their businesses more productive. The average apprenticeship completer increases business productivity by £214 per week

Attractive to customers - 81% of consumers favour companies that employ apprentices

Lower recruitment costs - 75% of apprentice employers say the programme has helped cut recruitment costs. 80% say that apprenticeships will play a bigger part in their future recruitment policy

Building skills - 82% of employers take on apprentices to build the skills capacity within their businesses





THE BENEFITS OF TAKING ON AN APPRENTICES DON'T STOP THERE...

Employers with paybills under £3m are entitled to 90% of their Apprenticeship training costs paid. Businesses with under 50 employees can have all their training costs paid if the apprentice is aged 16-18, or is a care leaver aged 19-24, or is a 19-24 year old with a local authority education and healthcare plan. Employers and training providers each receive an additional £1k to support younger apprentices with additional learning needs.
